ELY mounted and installed a diverse collection of James Bond movie props, from a bullet necklace with diamonds to a 10 foot komodo dragon climbing down a wall, for the Spy Museum in 2012. The exhibit includes over 40 flat documents and books, ten mannequins, as well as model helicopters, a jet and a shark head suspended from the ceiling. One of the more challenging objects to mount was a deteriorating rubber octopus that required a mount supporting the length of each arm and cradling its heavily weighted head.
